100a - Exterior - Free of Hazards

1. Requirements

2600.

100.a. The exterior of the building and the building grounds or yard must be in good repair and free of hazards.

Description of Violation

There are 3 different areas where the concrete is in disrepair on the sidewalk leading from the side door posing a trip and fall hazard. The concrete is crumbling and broken away where some of the slabs come together. The largest area is approximately 1 foot long by 6 inches wide in the widest part.

Plan of Correction

On 7/14/25 at 345 PM, the PCHA contacted a masonry who made appointment to make repair 3 different areas where the concrete is in disrepair on the sidewalk leading from the side door posing a trip and fall hazard on 7/22/25 at 1000AM

On 7/15/25 at 9:00 AM, the PCHA made rounds and ensured the exterior of the building and building grounds and yard are in good repair and free of hazards. The front entrance was flagged and will also be repaired at the same time.

On 7/15/25 at 10:AM the PCHA held a 30 Mins QA meeting. Agenda, recent State annual inspection, one deficiency was found, 3 different areas where the concrete is in disrepair on the sidewalk leading from the side door posing a trip and fall hazard against, 2600. 100.a. The exterior of the building and building grounds or yard must be in good repair and free of hazards.

POC:- Beginning 7/16/25 at 9:00 AM, PCHA will make rounds daily to ensure all exterior of the building and building grounds and yard are in good repair and free of hazards, as follows:-?

Daily X 1 Week, Twice a Week, Weekly X 4 Weeks then Monthly X 1 Month. (See attached completed audit)

DCS to report any exterior of the building and building grounds and yard that require repair due to poor condition when noted.?

PCHA will continue to educate DCS during QA meeting and perform random rounds to ensure exterior of the building and building grounds and yard are in good repair and free of hazards.

On 7/22/25 at 10:00 AM the masonry repaired the front entrance and the 3 areas cited. (Attached are the pics)
