## 42c - Treatment of Residents

**1. Requirements**

2600.

42.c. A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect.

**Description of Violation**

On [REDACTED] at approximately 6:30 am, staff person A, the LPN on duty, was responding to resident [REDACTED]'s call bell when [REDACTED] heard yelling all the way down the hallway. Upon entering the resident's room, staff person A witnessed direct care staff person B leaning over resident [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] recliner. Direct care staff B had both fists up and very close to the resident's face while yelling at [REDACTED] about not giving direct care staff person B the call bell to turn off.

**Plan of Correction****Accept [REDACTED] 09/03/2025)**

In response to the violation on 08/27/2025 by the Pennsylvania Bureau of Human Service Licensing, immediate action was taken:

1. on 08/01/2025 by the Administrator to Staff person "B" was immediately suspended pending investigation.
2. on 08/06/2025 by the Administrator to Staff person "B" was terminated from employment.

To enhance the currently compliant operations, on 08/08/2025 the Team members will complete training on Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation and Preventing, Recognizing, and Reporting Abuse on the Relais platform, with a completion date of 08/31/2025.

Effective 08/11/2025 the Administrator/Designee will perform private interviews for three residents a week for three months, then move to three residents a month until the end of the year through 12/31/2025 to maintain ongoing compliance with treating residents with dignity and respect. Any deficiencies will be corrected immediately, and findings will be documented and reviewed internally for continuous improvement purposes.
