At approximately 9:15 a.m., there was an unlabeled, undated plate of pumpkin roll covered in cling wrap and a Styrofoam take out container in the lower-level resident refrigerator, and an unlabeled, undated frozen breakfast sandwich in the lower-level resident freezer.

At the time of the inspection I █ the administrator was presents and did label all the unlabeled contents. I then did follow up and did re-training with the staff of the importance of freezer/refrigeration storage and labeling, I also spoke w/ all the residents to make them aware of the proper storage along with posting a note as a reminder. In the future I did make all staff aware that they must monitor each refrigerator/freezer on each shift. See Attached
