Resident [REDACTED] has a brain stimulator to treat [REDACTED] and it requires regular maintenance and monitoring; however, this need is not identified on resident [REDACTED] assessment, dated [REDACTED]

Plan of Correction

On 9/23/2025 all staff were educated on regulation 2600.225c by the Executive Director. On 9/23/2025 PCHA designee updated resident #1's support plan to include the deep brain stimulator including its maintenance and monitoring. PCHA designee also completed audit of all resident support plans to ensure information regarding medical devices, treatments, and specialized equipment needs are included in their RASP to ensure compliance with regulation 2600.225c.

PCHA will conduct 5 random audits of resident support plans monthly for 3 months and then randomly thereafter to ensure ongoing compliance with regulation 2600.225c. Documentation of these audits shall be retained by the PCHA.

Education on regulation 2600.225c will continue with staff monthly for 3 months and then annually thereafter. PCHA will retain documentation of the staff education in accordance with 2600.65i. The monthly staff training shall begin on 10/28/2025 and shall include training for all current staff persons.
