On [REDACTED] at approximately 5:15 a.m. resident [REDACTED] was found in bed not breathing by staff person A. Resident [REDACTED] did not have a Do Not Resuscitate order on file. Through staff interviews it was determined that staff person A, who is trained in first aid and CPR did not immediately provide CPR to resident [REDACTED]
