88a - Surfaces

1. Requirements

2600.

88.a. Floors, walls, ceilings, windows, doors and other surfaces must be clean, in good repair and free of hazards.

Description of Violation

At 10:30 a.m. several vinyl floor tiles in resident [redacted]'s room near the resident's bed were loose and not adhered to the floor securely allowing the tiles to move around easily and create a trip hazard.

Plan of Correction

Accepted ([redacted] - 11/24/2025)

POC:

On 11/06/2025, the Administrator notified the maintenance department of a broken, loose floor tile in the residents' room. Maintenance stated he has ordered new flooring for that room and a few others. In the interim, the Administrator found some existing tiles of the same pattern and repaired the broken floor tile. The administrator re-glued the loose tiles around the broken tile. The replaced tile is lighter in color but has the same print. It was glued with floor tile adhesive and shall not raise or become loose.

11/23/25, Administrator rechecked the replaced tile to ensure it has stayed in place.
