1. Requirements

2600.

183.b. Prescription medications, OTC medications, CAM and syringes shall be kept in an area or container that is locked. This includes medications and syringes kept in the resident's room.

Description of Violation

At 925 A.M., the medication cart was unlocked, unattended, and accessible in the common area on the second floor of the new section of the home.

Upon notification on 11/19/2025 during inspection I, [REDACTED] Personal Care Home administrator immediately locked medication cart.

Immediately post exit conference on 11/19/2025, all medication carts were audited by [REDACTED] Personal Care Home administrator to ensure they were properly locked and thru out the day on 11/19/2025.

MedTech on duty was counseled and received education by [REDACTED], personal care home administrator on 11/20/2025 in regard to 183b Meds and Syringes Locked. Emphasis of education included the privacy and safety concerns of leaving the cart unlocked.

All remaining medtech's were counseled received education by [REDACTED], personal care home administrator on 11/20/2025 in regard to 183b Meds and Syringes Locked. Emphasis of education included the privacy and safety concerns of leaving the cart unlocked.
