1. Requirements

2600.

27.a. If a home agrees to admit a resident eligible for SSI benefits, the home's charges for actual rent and other services may not exceed the SSI resident's actual current monthly income reduced by the current personal needs allowance.

Description of Violation

The home's administrator is representative payee for several residents in the home who receive SSI benefits, including, but not limited to residents [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. On [REDACTED], the administrator gave notice to residents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] that there would be a new charge of [REDACTED] per month for representative payee services, which would be taken from the residents' monthly personal needs allowance. And on [REDACTED], the administrator collected the [REDACTED] fee from SSI residents.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 12/30/2025)

Effective immediately, [REDACTED] Administrator of Ebony's Blessings Personal Care Home, discontinued serving as representative payee for all residents receiving SSI benefits. The home no longer charges or collects any representative payee fees, and no fees are deducted from residents' personal needs allowances. All SSI residents, including residents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], were provided written 30-day notice that Ursuline Representative Payee Services is now the independent representative payee for all SSI residents. Moving forward, the home will not act as representative payee for any SSI resident and will ensure that charges for rent and services do not exceed the resident's SSI income minus the required personal needs allowance, in compliance with 55 Pa. Code §2600.27(a). The administrator will monitor SSI billing upon admission and annually thereafter to ensure continued compliance.
