Uncovered cupcakes were covered on 11/21/25 at 10:11 am by [REDACTED] designee. Immediate staff training provided to [REDACTED] designee, and [REDACTED], care aide on 11/21/25 at 10:11 am. Monthly food/food storage audits will be done by [REDACTED], Administrator. Daily food storage audit will be done x 1 week started 12/29/25 to ensure proper compliance of food protection.
