Description of Violation

At 12:21 p.m. resident [redacted]'s room [redacted] had a heavy odor of smoke. Extinguished cigarette butts were found under resident [redacted]'s bed and in the trash can which caused the heavy odor of smoke in the room. According to staff, resident [redacted] has a habit of bringing cigarette butts back to the room in their coat pocket after smoking in the outdoor smoking area.

Plan of Correction

The violation occurred because the resident is saving cigarette butts and keeping them in pockets. the cigarette butts are falling on the floor or being thrown in the garbage instead of remaining outside the building. The immediate fix to the violation was the staff cleaning room and speaking to resident regarding leaving the cigarette butts outside and not save them. To prevent this violation in the future the room will be checked daily and removed from the room and remind the resident daily not to bring them in coat due to smell and the cigarette butts in [redacted] pockets and litter the room with them.
