Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] at approximately 7:33 a.m. Resident [REDACTED] was chatting with another resident at their table. Resident [REDACTED] was sitting behind Resident [REDACTED], at a different table. Resident [REDACTED] walked over to Resident [REDACTED] and poured a partial bottle of water over their head.

Upon notification on 11/21/25, I [REDACTED] Personal Care Home administrator immediately implemented a supervision plan for both residents which consisted of 15 min checks and a staff member present when both residents were in the dining room or any common room together while investigation was pending. Supervision plan was put into place indefinitely following the conclusion of investigation.

Immediately following supervision plan on 11/21/25 both POA's were notified. Report was also called in and sent via fax to OAPS on 11/21/25. Written report was sent to DHS on 11/21/25. Phone call was placed to Jason Harvey from DHS due to resident [REDACTED]'s POA stating [REDACTED] was making a complaint because [REDACTED] didn't like the supervision plan that was put in place to protect both resident's involved.

The owner of Alexandria Manor and myself spoke with resident # [REDACTED] POA and gave alternative options to the supervision plan, POA for resident [REDACTED] ultimately decided to move resident #1 to a different Alexandria Manor location.

Supervision plan was in place until resident [REDACTED] moved to Alexandria Manor Bethlehem on 12/5/25.

Resident [REDACTED] has had no previous behaviors or concerns.

All resident records were audit on 11/24/25 for possible behaviors and monitored daily for dignity and respect. All were found to be in compliance. All staff were educated during shift change on 11/24/25 and 11/25/25 regarding monitoring, documenting and communicating daily resident behaviors or changes in behavior to medtech on duty, administrator or designee.

I, [REDACTED] Personal Care Home administrator, started random daily audits of supervision plan on 11/21/25. Audits were completed on 12/5/25 when resident [REDACTED] transferred to Alexandria Manor Bethlehem.

On [REDACTED] at 10:30 a.m., the administrator showed the video of an incident that occurred on [REDACTED] in the dining area of the home between Residents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Video recording in common areas of the home is prohibited.

Upon notification on 2/6/26 via email from [REDACTED] DHS inspector regarding regulation 42s, owner was contacted and [REDACTED] placed a call to Digital Oasis, camera company for Alexandria Manor.

Appointment was made for 2/18/26 to have Digital Oasis come out and service camera system to remove recording function on all common area camera's.

As of 2/18/26 recording function has been removed on all common area cameras, all signage for staff related area, exits and parking lots have been reviewed and found to be present as required.

Administrator and Owner have been educated and reviewed regulation 42s.
