103f - Refrigerator/Freezer Temps

1. Requirements

2600.

103.f. Food requiring refrigeration shall be stored at or below 40°F. Frozen food shall be kept at or below 0°F. Thermometers are required in refrigerators and freezers.

Description of Violation

On [redacted] at 2:55 PM, the freezer in the breezeway measured 10 degrees Fahrenheit.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 01/20/2026)

All food items, including the 3 boxes of waffles and 5 lbs. of ground beef, in the breezeway freezer were discarded after the inspector left the facility to ensure food safety. Then, the temperature in the freezer was at once adjusted to the coldest setting by the administrator and verified to be below 0 degrees Fahrenheit at 8:00 PM on 12/18/2025. On December 19,2025, the administrator conducted a staff meeting to address a freezer temperature violation. During the discussion, staff were reminded that for safety, freezers must keep a temperature at or below 0 degrees Fahrenheit, and refrigerators must be kept at or below 40 degrees Fahrenheit. Attached are the summary of the staff meeting on 12/19/2025 and pictures of the thermometer inside the breezeway freezer, showing a temperature below 0 degrees Fahrenheit. Attached the receipt for the purchase of 2 new thermometers on 01/08/2026 to make sure we have immediate replacements available if any of the current thermometer malfunction. Attached the Checklist started 01/08/2026 for administrator or staff on duty will check 3 times daily to ensure the safety and compliance of all stored items and to guarantee the freezers' temperature is at or below 0 degrees Fahrenheit and refrigerators should be at or below 40 degrees Fahrenheit. Ensure freezers and refrigerators have an operable thermometer inside. If freezer is above 0 degrees Fahrenheit and refrigerators is above 40 degrees Fahrenheit, Report to the administrator at once. Change the thermometer and wait for 1 hour. If the temperature stays the same, discard all food, and arrange for appliance repair or replacement.
