64.c. An administrator shall have at least 24 hours of annual training relating to the job duties. The Department-approved administrator training course specified in subsection (a) fulfills the annual training requirement for the first year.

Staff person A, the home's administrator, completed only 12.5 hours of Department-approved training in training year 2025.

2. Requirements

2600.

89.c. A home that is not connected to a public water system shall have a coliform water test at least every 3 months, by a Department of Environmental Protection-certified laboratory, stating that the water is below maximum contaminant levels. A public water system is a system that provides water to the public for human consumption, which has at least 15 service connections or regularly serves an average of at least 25 individuals daily at least 60 days out of the year.

Description of Violation

The home has not had a coliform water test since October 2022. The home is not connected to a public water source.

The home recognizes the importance of this regulation, which ensures that homes with private water sources are safe to use.

The home entered into a new contract with Meyer's Environmental Services to have a coliform water test completed quarterly, with the next service date set for 2/4/2026.

Resident [redacted] did not have access to a source of light that can be turned on/off at bedside.

The home recognizes the importance of this regulation, which ensures residents have adequate lighting to move

Housekeeping and maintenance staff will ensure that all residents have lighting within reach of their beds.

The home moved resident [REDACTED] bedside lamp back over to his nightstand.
