185a - Implement Storage Procedures

1. Requirements

2600.

185.a. The home shall develop and implement procedures for the safe storage, access, security, distribution and use of medications and medical equipment by trained staff persons.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] at approximately 1:05 p.m., Resident [REDACTED] glucometer readings were observed showing dates which did not match the Medication Administration Report for the period of [REDACTED] through [REDACTED]. The Glucometer was not calibrated to the correct date.

Resident [REDACTED] is prescribed a blood sugar check once daily. On [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] the check was completed but the blood sugar reading was not documented on the Medication Administration Record.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 02/10/2026)

Action: Resident [REDACTED] glucometer was calibrated to the correct time and date on [REDACTED] during the inspection. Medication Technicians were verbally educated to note correct time and date on all glucometers prior to use and to ensure when approving blood sugar check orders that they have supplementary documentation added to accurately record the results.

Training: The Executive Director will educate the Director of Nursing, Assistant Director of Nursing and Medication Technicians on regulation 2600.185a relating to accurate glucometer calibration and ensuring supplementary documentation for glucometer orders by 2/27/2026.

Ongoing: The Director of Nursing and/or Assistant Director of Nursing will implement, and review, daily glucometer audits for completeness and accuracy on a weekly basis starting the week of 2/16/2026. The glucometer audits will be reviewed and discussed during the monthly Quality Assurance meeting starting March 2026 for a period of 1 month. The Executive Director, Director of Nursing and/or Assistant Director of Nursing will review all new blood sugar orders to ensure supplementary documentation is added to accurately record the residents' blood sugar.
