103.g. Food shall be stored in closed or sealed containers.

Description of Violation

At 1:45P.M., the home's walk-in kitchen freezer contained a plastic bag of frozen breadsticks that were opened and unsealed.

Plan of Correction**Accept (█ - 03/12/2026)**

During inspection, a package of frozen breadsticks was in an appropriately enclosed box, but when the box was opened, the plastic packaging of the breadsticks was not resealed appropriately.

Immediate action taken: breadsticks were discarded into trash.

Root cause analysis: newly hired employee (second day at work) was under mistaken assumption that █ correctly sealed the breadsticks when █ closed the box. (employee resigned)

Response to receipt of violation: All kitchen staff members were retrained on 2/4/26 on how to correctly seal packages, including ones with plastic bags in boxes (both parts need to be sealed).

Action taken to prevent recurrence: Executive director and designated kitchen team member randomly audited 5 boxed items in freezer per week for 4 weeks to make sure they were sealed correctly--no repeat violations were discovered. Ongoing compliance: kitchen team member to audit freezer items when put into use for the menu to ensure long term compliance and bring any violations to ED's attention and further corrective actions (retraining and more intensive auditing)
