1. Requirements

2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] Resident [REDACTED] received a fraud alert from the credit card company that an individual had attempted to make a purchase of [REDACTED] at a Walmart located in Easton, PA and this purchase was declined by the company. Additional purchases of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were made using Resident [REDACTED]'s credit at a Walmart in Easton, PA. Local law enforcement were able to obtain the surveillance video for the dates and times that the fraudulent charges were made on Resident [REDACTED] credit card and generate a picture for identification. Staff person A identified the individual in the photograph as Staff person B. Staff person B had worked the overnight shift the days prior to Resident [REDACTED] credit cards and bank card going missing and fraudulent charges being made. Local law enforcement has charged Staff person B for making fraudulent charges on Resident [REDACTED] credit cards.

Plan of Correction

Accept ([REDACTED] - 05/07/2026)

On 4/3/2026 immediately following the identification of staff person B from the incident the Executive Director terminated staff person B. The Executive Director on 4/17 during monthly staff training did a education with all staff on regulation 2600.42.b abuse, financial abuse and financial exploitation. The executive director or designee will be responsible for ongoing compliance.
