1. Requirements

2600.

42.c. A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect.

Description of Violation

On Friday [redacted] at 4:45p.m. when residents were returning from the day program, a verbal argument erupted between resident [redacted] and resident [redacted] as the residents were exiting the van and walking towards the home. Just before the residents entered the home, resident [redacted] pushed resident [redacted] and [redacted] fell on the ground. landed on and broke [redacted] quad cane, and scratched [redacted] back.

Plan of Correction

On 3/26/26, resident [redacted] was issued a discharge from the home.

During the month of April, all staff in the home were trained in Dignity and Respect training with the Ombudsman.

On 4/30/26, the Case Manager educated all residents in the home on Dignity and Respect.

On 4/30/26, the Case Manager began interviews with 1 resident per week, privately to ensure they feel they are being treated with Dignity and Respect. Interviews will be completed x 4 weeks; documentation will be kept.
