On 5/5/26 at 10AM, the administrator held a meeting with direct care staff about recent state surveyor and the deficiencies.

PCHA re-educated DCS on 55 Pa. Code Chapter 2600.141.b. 1 Pennsylvania Department of Human Services regulation for Personal Care Homes. It mandates that every resident must receive a medical evaluation at least annually.

Resident #1's medical evaluation was dated 3/5/25, past due.
