Description of Violation

On [REDACTED], resident [REDACTED] told staff [REDACTED] was going to kill [REDACTED] and attempted to wheel [REDACTED] out to the middle of the road before being brought back to the home by the staff. EMS and police were called to the home to assist the resident, and [REDACTED] was transported to the hospital for mental health evaluation. This was not reported to the Department.

Plan of Correction**Accept [REDACTED] - 07/07/2026)**

Clarification- After resident was wheeled back from close to the road is when the resident announced their possible intentions, they did not announce and then move that direction, an intervention would have occurred.

Immediate correction was to file a late report on 6-1-26 citing the incident and posted the PA rules for filing reports in office of RCC. Copy of photo attached.

Also, had additional supplemental training for all staff to help identify reportable incidents to help the RCC file a timely report, see documentation.

Ongoing, the administrator will assist RCC where needed and check monthly with the RCC to verify proper reporting was accomplished when needed.

Resident [REDACTED] was prescribed [REDACTED], apply to left foot and between toes daily. However, the resident was not administered this medication on [REDACTED].

Immediate action taken to verbally review missed documentation with med tech that was working that day on 6-1-26.

A training session for med techs was performed to reinforce importance of following the Dr's directions for medicines, in that training we taught them to look for the reminders that the computer presents each day. Documentation attached.

Ongoing, we will initially monitor the proper documentation on following Dr. requirements with end of the shift checks daily and after 1 week of daily checks convert to a weekly check for 4 weeks then a monthly inspection for 10 months after that.

Resident [REDACTED] assessment, dated [REDACTED], did not indicate the resident's behaviors, including threatening to kill [REDACTED] on more than one occasion, by wheeling out into the road, throwing items at staff, and frequent outbursts.
