2600.

181.c. The resident's assessment shall identify if the resident is able to self-administer medications as specified in § 2600.227(e) (relating to development of the support plan). Resident [REDACTED] self-administers over the counter medication to include Tums; however, resident [REDACTED] has been assessed as not being able to self-administer their medications.

The Tums were immediately removed from Resident [REDACTED] room on [REDACTED]. Resident [REDACTED] was re-educated in Regulations 181a-181f on 6/8/2026 by Administrator, [REDACTED]. Resident [REDACTED] was assessed to self-administer some medications but not others by [REDACTED] CRNP on 6/23/2026. New orders received on 6/25/2026 to self-administer some meds but not others, Tums to take as directed; keep bedside and self-administer for heartburn/indigestion. An addendum was finalized for Resident [REDACTED]'s current RASP on 6/25/2026 by Administrator, [REDACTED]. All medtechs and Administrator, [REDACTED] are responsible to ensure Regulation 181c are maintained and compliance upheld. Therefore, all medtechs will be re-educated in Regulations 181a-f, with emphasis on Self-Administration; Medication Administration assessment, support plan, storage, disposal, and medical supplies on Tuesday 6/30 and Thursday 7/2/2026 by Administrator, [REDACTED]. On Monday 6/29, Administrator, [REDACTED] and Med Tech Supervisor, [REDACTED] will begin resident room audits, weekly x 4; then monthly thereafter, to ensure compliance with Regulations 181a-f are maintained. 2600.

183.b. Prescription medications, OTC medications, CAM and syringes shall be kept in an area or container that is locked. This includes medications and syringes kept in the resident's room.

Description of Violation

At 10:15a.m., there was nystatin powder on the side table in Resident [REDACTED]'s room. The medication was unlocked, unattended, and accessible to Resident [REDACTED]. Resident [REDACTED] is unable to self administer medications.

Plan of Correction

The Nystatin Powder was immediately removed from Resident [REDACTED]'s room on 6/4/2026. Resident [REDACTED] was re-educated in Regulations 183b on 6/8/2026 by Administrator, [REDACTED]. Resident [REDACTED] was assessed to self-administer some medications but not others by [REDACTED] CRNP on 6/23/2026. New orders received on 6/25/2026 to self-administer some meds but not others; Nystatin Powder 100,000 units apply topically 2 x daily as needed to inguinal crease-may keep bedside-may self-administer for fungal infection. An addendum was finalized for Resident [REDACTED]'s current RASP on 6/25/2026 by Administrator, [REDACTED]. All medtechs and Administrator, [REDACTED] are responsible to ensure Regulation 183b are maintained and compliance upheld. Therefore, all medtechs will be re-educated in Regulations 183b, with emphasis on Self-Administration; Medication Administration assessment, support plan, storage, disposal, and medical supplies on Tuesday 6/30 and Thursday 7/2/2026 by Administrator, [REDACTED].
