Description of Violation

Multiple staff interviews indicate resident [REDACTED] has behavior problems, including urinating in trash cans and on walls, pulling [REDACTED] pants down to urinate in common areas in front of other [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] residents, and defecating in [REDACTED] hands and placing it in a [REDACTED] resident's private bathroom trash can. However, resident [REDACTED]'s assessment, dated 11/20/25, does not address these needs.

Resident [REDACTED] assessment, dated 11/20/25, does not address the resident care need for Pseudo-Seizures, anxiety, and depression related to discussing [REDACTED] past.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 07/30/2026)

Immediate action: the inspector found 2 residents with support plans that were not personalized enough to discuss their needs

Corrective action: Asst admin and admin reviewed RASP with inspector and received more education on person-centered care regarding support plans. Resident 1&2 RASP were updated to be person centered. Resident [REDACTED] discharged from this facility. Resident 2 RASP was updated to include person-centered needs of pseudo-seizures.

Preventative action: Asst admin and admin will provide person-centered care on all RASPs. Asst admin and admin

will work together to complete RASPs as person centered and review each other's work. New admission, Norma, was completed as person centered. All RASP will be person centered.
