2. Requirements

2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] at approximately 5:45 p.m., resident [REDACTED] was standing at the entrance to resident [REDACTED]'s room on the home's secured dementia care unit. Resident [REDACTED] came towards resident #1 swinging a green plastic hanger hitting resident [REDACTED] on the left upper arm. Resident [REDACTED] put both arms out in front of [REDACTED] to push resident [REDACTED] away from [REDACTED] causing both residents to fall to the ground. Both residents were sent to separate hospitals via EMS. Resident [REDACTED] returned from the hospital with diagnoses of "Fall, [REDACTED]." Resident [REDACTED] was admitted to trauma/surgery for observation and discharged back to the home in the afternoon on [REDACTED]. Resident [REDACTED] hospital records indicate that "patient endorses pain in the back of head as well as the right shoulder." Physical exam notes indicate posterior scalp hematoma. CT results indicate:

Immediately, observed the violation regarding 42b in the RCG. Additional education via [REDACTED] on phone call on 7/15/26 gaining understanding on 42b.

Resident [REDACTED] is no longer in the facility and was placed elsewhere. Audited behavior and progress notes of resident [REDACTED]

Additional education given to staff regarding 42b via site communication platform. Planned dementia training to be completed during July monthly training, will revisit supervision as well as behavior modification techniques

Behavior tracker documentation task for 2 continuous weeks monitored by DON or administrator. This will be monitored daily for 2 weeks, then weekly for 4 weeks. Will increase supervision with resident if noting wandering, agitation, or anxiety.
